Re: Street Acceptance – Hope Street

The Department of Public Works Engineering Division completed inspections during the construction of Hope Street to confirm compliance with City standards. Based on the inspections, the Department of Public Works recommends the following action to accept Hope Street (roadway intersecting with North Main Street and Riverside Avenue) as a City Street:

- **Recommend City Council approve the street acceptance of Hope Street, described as, varying in width from 50-65 feet and running from the eastern side of North Main Street at the intersection of North Main Street and Laurel Street in an easterly direction approximately 900 feet, intersecting with Riverside Avenue (northern side) as a public highway and to be so named.**

The traffic signal at the intersection of North Main Street, Laurel Street & Hope Street is operational, however the current signal equipment will be removed when the new signal is supplied with power from Eversource (scheduled for the end of April).

In addition, DPW recommends the following action to revise the existing roadway right of way limits of Riverside Avenue between Hope Street and North Main Street and on North Main Street between Riverside Avenue and Hope Street in order to include the area on the existing North Creek Conduit and storm drainage. Revising the existing roadway right of way will include the area of public storm drainage and eliminate the need for developers to obtain a zoning variance since regulations require the construction of building along the roadway.

- **Approve revisions to the existing roadway right of way to increase the width approximately 10 feet along Riverside Avenue (north side) between Hope Street and North Main Street and on North Main Street (east side) between Riverside Avenue and Hope Street.**
