Re: Roadside Barrier Installation – Brier Road & East Road

The DPW has received a request to install a roadside barrier at the corner of Brier Road and East Road. In response to a previous request for a barrier, the Department indicated that due to the presence of a series of trees at the corner a barrier was not warranted. The Department did however install a section of elevated concrete curb. Since the original request a vehicle turning onto Brier Road jumped the curb. In addition, the four trees that provided a level of protection to the house have been removed and the property owner has indicated that the remaining trees are scheduled to be removed. As a result the Department of Public Works requests the following Board of Public Works action:

Approve installation of a roadside barrier at the corner of East Road and Brier Road.

The cost to install the referenced barrier is \$7,800 and will be funded through the Departments major roadway maintenance account. A picture of the area is attached.
