Re: Permanent Patch Bond – Great Pyrenees

In lieu of cash or a check, Engineering will be accepting a bond from Rock Builders for \$10,000 to cover costs for permanent patch within the cul de sac of Great Pyrenees Way. This will be a separate bond than that for the subdivision. While the subdivision bond covers the reconstruction of the cul de sac, the developer has up to ten years to complete the subdivision and this reconstruction. Given the history of cul de sac extensions and the complications that arise, Engineering has requested a Permanent patch fee. The bond that Engineering is accepting as part of the Excavation Permit will cover the patch required to extend sanitary sewer into the subdivision. This will insure that the patch for the sewer in the cul de sac is maintained in a usable state for residents, emergency services and public works. Engineering will inspect the patch and install a permanent patch if the reconstruction of the cul de sac is not performed in a timely manner.
