Re: Urban Act Grant - CT Department of Energy & Environmental Protection
Installation of Sedimentation Basin – Pine Lake

The City has received an Urban Act Grant from the Department of Energy & Environmental Protection to install a sedimentation basin at Pine Lake. The proposed structure will replace the existing surface basin located east of Surrey Drive with a subsurface basin that will increase sediment collection prior to discharging storm water to Pine Lake.

In addition to execution of DEEP grant documents, approval from the City's Inland Wetland Commission will also be required to construct the project. Therefore, the Department of Public Works requests the following City Council action:

Mayor Authorization to sign any and all documents associated with the installation of a sedimentation basin at Pine Lake including execution of a CT Urban Act grant in the amount of \$51,459.77 and execution of any and all state and local land use/ environmental permits.
