RE: Eversource Project Update

The Department of Public Works has been contacted by Eversource Energy regarding replacing of gas mains and proposed tree trimming within the City.

Gas main replacement / City road restoration

Eversource's gas main replacement work will require excavation of City roads. In accordance with City requirements Eversource will install a temporary roadway patch at the time of the initial installation and is required to install a permanent pavement patch at the completion of work. Based on a review of the current condition of the roadway pavements, the roads in question are scheduled to be milled and paved by the DPW. In lieu of Eversource installing a permanent patch they have agreed to provide payment to the City that will cover a portion of the Department's resurface cost (mill & pave road curb to curb).

The DPW will require a meeting with representatives of Eversource, Bristol Police and Board of Education to review traffic control prior to the start of any work. Eversource has also been permitted to start work on the project in the Divinity Street/Peck Lane area subject to using hot reclaimed asphalt (cold patch asphalt is not allowed).

It should also be noted that a portion of the Eversource's work is proposed on the section of Riverside Ave scheduled to be milled and paved by the DOT. The work will require DOT authorization and may impact the schedule to mill and pave Riverside Avenue.

A copy of the submitted Eversource correspondence indicating the location of the proposed gas main replacement is attached for your reference. The Information will be forwarded to the Water/WPC Department and posted in the Department's website.

Tree Trimming/ Cutting

Eversource Energy has requested authorization to cut and remove trees in the area indicated on the attached maps to prevent fallen trees from disrupting electrical service. As indicated in the attached email Eversource policy consist of notifying the City's Tree Warden and communicating directly with property owners in the affected area.



Ray –

As a follow up to our phone conversation, here is a short description of the protocol for contacting the tree warden and Bristol residents for tree trimming:

I will initiate a meeting with the tree warden to go over the town trimming maps and see if there are any issues or conflicts with planned road work. The town permit gives permission for trimming town trees. The tree warden, or their appointed deputy/assistant, will be the primary point of contact to get permission for removing tree hazards in close proximity to the electric conductors.

In addition to the town permit, Bristol residents will receive a door hanger at properties that require tree trimming or removal of private trees. The hanger will contain a consent form and a packet describing the reason for trimming and the trimming specification at that property along with the contact information of the Asplundh work planner. The property owner must provide consent for the trimming to commence, unless the vegetation is in contact with the conductors (CT General Statute 16-234-E). If the trees in front of a property are on town property, and not private property, the property owner will receive a notification of the trimming specification because the town permit covers the trimming of town trees. If they have an issue with the proposed tree trimming on town trees they are given a grace period of 15 days to provide a written objection to the tree warden (indicated in the door hanger information), which we would typically meet with the resident to discuss the trimming and possible solutions or have a town hall if necessary. Please let me know if you have any further questions or concerns.
