RE: Central Monitoring Services - update

The Department of Public Works currently has a general bid out for Central Monitoring Services of City Buildings (including Parks Facilities), which closes on May 1, 2020. At this time, A&A Security provides this monitoring service and the existing contract expires on June 30, 2020.

The Building Committee previously approved an allocation of \$25,000, to prepare for the potential shift to a new monitoring vendor, so that on July 1st, we will maintain both fire and security monitoring at the locations below without a loss of coverage:

Main & Manross Libraries	Beals Community Center	Rockwell Park Pool & Pavilion
Park Page Pool & Pavilion	D. Malone Aquatic Center	City Hall
51 High Street	Public Works City Yard	Fire House #4

Costs will also cover any upgrades to existing systems and replacement of proprietary fire panel and security panel dialers, which may be required in advance of the July 1st contract date.
