Monthly Report

April, 2021

Summary

Station 2 personnel conducted 10 area surveys for the month of April. With the arrival of spring comes spring cleaning assignments and hose testing. Some shifts are well into the cleaning and some hose testing has already been completed. Engine 2 personnel responded to 19 calls for service in the month of April.

Personnel

It was a pleasure having FF Anthony Bentivengo at Station 2 the past two months. He was enthusiastic and was eager to learn. He was assigned to HQ for the month of April.

Apparatus/Equipment

The engine repair work on Engine 2 was completed and it was returned to service at the beginning of the month. SCBA E2-01 was taken OOS due to an air leak and sent out for service. The boat motor was running rough and was serviced by FET Kelly. It was taken to the lake and run in order to keep it running smoothly. Taking it out on the lake will now be done on a monthly basis so it stays ready to go. The new Hurst E-tool was leaking hydraulic fluid so it had to be taken OOS and is being sent out for repair.

Fire Stations/Facilities

N.E. garage door was on site to repair one of the overhead doors. Air Temp came to change a mixing valve for the domestic hot water in order to increase the water temperature. The Matthews St. ramps' deteriorating condition has caused an injury to a FF who twisted his ankle getting out of his vehicle in the morning. Facilities manager David Oakes is aware of the problem with the ramp and has said it will be replaced soon.
