Monthly Report

May 2021

Summary

Tower 1 responded to 59 incidents during the month of April. Notable calls included a fire in the laundry room at the Double Tree Hotel and 3 extrications. Crews have been conducting surveys of various buildings. These totaled 10 different occupancies for a duration of 10 hours.

Personnel

Nothing to report.

Apparatus/Equipment

Tower 1 was involved in an accident at Fire HQ. While responding to a reported MVA with an occupant trapped in a burning vehicle, the driver turned too sharply while pulling out and struck the building between bays one and two. There was damage to Tower 1 and minor damage to the overhead door weather stripping. Repairs will be forthcoming.

Fire Stations/Facilities

The new dishwasher is still out of service. The warranty repair was completed and it only worked for a few days. I have requested a complete replacement of the unit. This has been ongoing for 7 months. We still do not have window screens or blinds in the firehouse. This has been ongoing for 9 months. All overhead door openers have been replaced and appear to be working correctly. There are still several quality issues with the installation. Work has begun on updating the monument on the corner of Center and North Main St.
