1. Call to Order

4. Updates by Dave Oakes, Public Facilities & Energy Manager

Dave Oakes provided the Commission with updates:

- LED project at the Library is on its final punch list items to closeout, a wiring problem was discovered but is being resolved.
- Utility Audit is progressing, they are working with Eversource to retrieve data.
- SustainableCT – the Mayor has approved the media kit, Sean has a piece for the Energy Commission to be involved. June 8 is the kick off date with Posigen. The in person workshops will be replaced with webinars which will take place at the end of June. These will be recorded to be replayed. They are working on outreach to the community with social media and school lunch distribution along with the Farmer's Market and Bristol Cares monthly meeting.
- Lindsey Rivers is going to be recognized with a documentary on CPTV for her garden projects, Sean told Dave to send the Commission's appreciation to Lindsey for her efforts.
- Ray stated CT Solar is the preferred developer for the landfill project
- Bloom Energy has also approached the City to lease land and place a fuel cell on it, if this is a lease agreement the City would go through Real Estate Committee and not the RFP process, but it could be a potential revenue generator for the Transfer Station

5. 2020 Commission Goals

Sean stated the Commission began this discussion last month, he has spoken to Rob Longo for the Energy Commission to meet with him regarding their energy efforts prior to the June or July Water Commission meeting to discuss shared savings.

The Energy Commission would also like to get involved with the Memorial Boulevard project
