1. APPROVAL TO SUBMIT SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT TO COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT ANNUAL ACTION PLAN 2019-2020 TO ASSIST ST. VINCENT DE PAUL TO EXPAND SERVICES TO HOMELESS PEOPLE AT RISK FOR COVID-19.

Communication from the Grants Administrator regarding a proposal from St. Vincent DePaul to renovate the second and third floors of their building to allow more residents while still maintaining social distancing.

On motion of Council Member Preleski and seconded, it was unanimously voted: To approve the City's submission of a Substantial Amendment to its Annual Action Plan for 2019-2020 to HUD to address the COVID-19 pandemic by accepting a CARES Act grant for \$393,989 from HUD and using those funds to assist St. Vincent De Paul to expand services to homeless people at risk of catching and spreading the virus. It was also voted to allow the Mayor or Acting Mayor to sign any documents related to the submission of this Substantial Amendment and its obligations, and to forward this information to the Board of Finance for any necessary action.

2. REQUEST FROM BLOOM ENERGY INC. TO LEASE ASSESSOR'S MAP 4 LOT 17-1 (671 LAKE AVENUE) REFERRED TO REAL ESTATE COMMITTEE, PLANNING COMMISSION FOR SEC. 8-24 REVIEW, AND BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS.

Communication presented from the Public Works Director regarding a request from Bloom Energy Inc. to lease a portion of City owned property at 671 Lake Avenue, Department of Public Works transfer station.

Public Works Director Rogozinski stated this was an opportunity to provide another revenue stream for the transfer station.

On motion of Council Member Hahn and seconded, it was unanimously voted: To refer a request from Bloom Energy Inc. to lease a portion of City owned property identified as Assessor's Map 4 Lot 17-1 to the Real Estate Committee, Planning Commission for a CT General Statutes Sec. 8-24 review, and the Board of Public Works for review and recommendation.
