At approximately 8:47 p.m. Wednesday several Bristol Officers, including a K-9 Unit, responded to a single-family home on Fairview Ave. when a neighbor reported a male breaking into the residence. Upon arrival officers discovered the male inside the residence and attempted to get the male to exit the residence on his own.

The male refused to cooperate and retreated further into the house as he barricaded himself in the attic. At this point officers from Bristol's Emergency Response Team (ERT) responded as it was unknown if the male possessed a weapon or had secured one from the attic area.

The male was eventually captured without any injury to him or officers.

Joseph Saluski, 41, of 73 Gridley Street in Bristol was charged with Burglary Third Degree, Criminal Attempt at Larceny Sixth Degree, Criminal Mischief Second Degree, Interfering with an Officer and Possession of Burglary Tools.

Saluski was able to post the \$30,000 bond placed on him however he was released to a Hartford P.D. Officer as that department held a Larceny arrest warrant for him.
