A motor vehicle stop lead to the arrest of two convicted felons on drug charges as they exited the Davis Drive area at approximately 7:32 p.m. Wednesday. The Bristol Officer observed the violation and subsequently stopped the vehicle as it pulled into the parking lot of Walgreens (525 Farmington Ave.)

The operator was identified as Matthew Aylward, 32, of 752 King Street in Bristol and the passenger as Roderick Mack, 43, of 42 Hoye Street in Terryville.

Further investigation by the officer located the illegal drugs prompting an arrest of the two occupants. Aylward was charged with Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Possession With Intent to Sell Within 1,500 Feet of a Prohibited Place (Davis Drive is part of the Bristol Housing Authority), Illegal Distribution/Sale of Narcotics and Illegal Possession of Narcotics.

Mack was charged with Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Illegal Possession of Narcotics, Tampering With Evidence and Interfering With an Officer.

Aylward was released from custody when he posted a \$25,000 bond and was given an 08-22-16 court date at G.A. 17. Mack was held on a \$10,000 bond pending an arraignment at G.A. 17 Thursday morning.
