Summary:

On Thursday, September 8, 2016 at approximately 11:00 am Bristol Patrol Officers responded to Faneuil Call Center, located at 32 Valley Street to assist the Bristol Fire Department on a report of carbon monoxide in the building.

Upon arriving, BPD Officers found the BFD had begun to evacuate employees of the business, along with other employees of several other businesses located within the building. Approximately 30 to 40 people working in the building were treated at the scene and transported to several local hospitals for symptoms associated with carbon monoxide exposure. There were no reports of any serious injuries at the scene.

At this time the BFD is clearing the building of any remaining carbon monoxide and a preliminary investigation determined that the cause of the carbon monoxide may have been a construction company working in the building.
