Summary:

On Wednesday, October 26, 2016 at approximately 09:30 hours BPD officers responded to the intersection of Memorial Blvd. and Willis Street for a reported serious accident. Upon arriving officers found that a box truck had left the roadway and crashed into the Pequabuck River. The driver of the box truck sustained minor injuries and was transported to Bristol hospital.

A preliminary investigation determined that the box truck was traveling north on Willis Street when the driver lost control of the truck and crashed into the Pequabuck River. DEP was called for diesel fuel leaking into the river from the truck. No other vehicles were involved in the accident and the accident remains under investigation.

At this time the westbound lane of Memorial Blvd. from Mellen Street to Main Street is closed.
