PRESS RELEASE

On Tuesday, January 16, 2017 at 6:32 a.m. Engines 1, 2, 5 and Tower 1 Of the Bristol Fire Department were dispatched to a reported structure fire at 14 Dwight St. The building is a three-story, six unit residence of ordinary construction.

First arriving fire units found heavy fire showing from a top floor apartment. Crews from Engine 1 and Tower 1 quickly advanced a hose line to the third floor and quickly extinguished the fire. The fire did not extend beyond the original apartment. Fire crews found no other occupants inside while searching the building. All occupants made it out of the building safely.

A total of 10 occupants, including two teenagers, were displaced because of the fire. The Red Cross is providing assistance to all those affected with immediate assistance packages and lodging.

There were no injuries reported, and the fire is under investigation by the Bristol Fire Marshal's Office.
