

# YARD WASTE COLLECTION

The City of Bristol offers a curbside yard waste collection service for an annual fee, currently **\$90.00** for the season. Subscribers receive a 95 gallon green yard waste container, which the City will deliver when your application and payment are received.

Yard Waste Collection is weekly (usually two days after your regular rubbish collection day) from the first full week of April through the first full week of December (*weather-permitting*). Paid subscribers will receive a sticker that must be adhered to the barrel. Yard waste service must be renewed each year.

***Barrels that do not have a current-year sticker will not be emptied.***

1. Yard waste container(s) can be used for grass, leaves, woodchips, vegetative waste, and small branches no thicker than 1 inch and no longer than 12 inches. *No sand, rocks, dirt, or sod allowed.*
2. Yard waste container(s) must be placed curbside by 6:00 a.m. on your designated collection day.
3. Yard waste containers must be placed with the front of the barrel facing the street, with the handle facing the property. Yard waste stickers should be applied to the side of the barrel, next to the City of Bristol logo, visible from the direction which the truck approaches.

To ensure appropriate access for collection, yard waste barrels should be separated by a minimum of five (5') feet from other barrels, parked vehicles, mailboxes, utility poles, and other objects.

# BRUSH/BRANCH COLLECTION

The City offers Brush/Branch Collection by appointment only from the first full week of April through the first full week of December (*weather-permitting*).

1. Brush and branches must be tied in secure bundles that one person can lift
2. Branches must be less than 6 inches in diameter and 4 feet in length.
3. Brush/branches must be placed curbside by 6:00 a.m. on your scheduled appointment day.
4. Piles cannot exceed 4 ft. x 4 ft. x 4 ft.

# LEAF BAG COLLECTION

The City of Bristol provides curbside leaf collection during Spring and Fall each year, typically April, and October/November (*weather-permitting*).

Leaves are collected only in brown, recyclable, paper leaf bags available at most home and garden stores. There is no maximum limit to leaf bag collection. Leaf bags containing dirt, sand, rocks, sod, or materials other than leaves will not be collected. Loose leaf piles will not be collected.

You may also bring all types of yard waste to the Transfer Station with a residential permit.
