

The Bristol Fire Marshal's Office is required by Section 29-305 of the Connecticut General Statutes to conduct Fire Safety Code Inspections of all buildings/spaces within the City of Bristol for compliance with the 2005 Connecticut Fire Safety Code, which incorporates the 2003 International Fire Code, 2003 NFPA 101 Life Safety Code, and the 2003 NFPA 1 Uniform Fire Code.

The intent of this checklist is to provide you with the required documentation of inspections and tests of fire safety equipment (as applicable for your building) available at the time of inspection.

Please note that some equipment may have monthly requirements that must be documented in addition to annual and semi-annual requirements.

Please consult with your Fire Prevention Contractors and/or this office if assistance or clarification is needed.

In addition to the required inspection and test reports, the following are some of the items that we will check during the inspection process.

- Exit doors
- Sprinkler head obstruction
- Electrical cord use
- Electrical panel access
- Handrail height & detail
- Door locking arrangement

The Bristol Fire Marshal's Office will offer assistance to help you achieve compliance with the Connecticut State Fire Safety Code.
