



**CITY OF BRISTOL
TITLE VI - CIVIL RIGHTS ACT OF 1964
POLICY STATEMENT**

PURPOSE

Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 prohibits discrimination on the basis of race, color, or national origin in its programs, activities and services receiving federal financial assistance. Accordingly, it is the policy of the City of Bristol to provide access to all of its programs, activities and services without discrimination in accordance with Title VI.

COMPLAINTS

Any person who believes that he or she has been subject to discrimination prohibited under Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 may file a discrimination complaint with:

Complaints must be filed in writing and signed by the complainant or a representative and should include the complainant's name, address, and contact information. Complaints must be filed within 180 days of the date of the alleged discriminatory act.
