Summary

The members of station 3 responded to 550 calls for service this year, this includes multiple structure fires, MVA's, and a myriad of other calls. These responses were all complicated by the ongoing pandemic. There have been a couple of quarantines for our members but no serious health issues. Company surveys have been impeded by the health concerns of exposure to our members. Covid-19 has affected every aspect of life at Station 3 including our emergency responses. On a brighter note our membership has been bolstered by a cadre of young ambitious firefighters.

Personnel

Lt. Mark Flynn was promoted to chief of the department. We also saw Al Rudolewicz and Adrienne Plourde promoted to lieutenant and stationed on Engine 3.

Apparatus/Equipment

Engine 3 has not had any major issues this year, there is one nagging issue with the transmission which will soon be ironed out. Engine 8 is still in acceptable shape, but it is showing its age.

Fire Stations/Facilities

There was an AC system installed this year but was undersized for our needs, this will be addressed this spring. The kitchen project has been postponed due to the pending purchase.
