

# Engine Company 2

## Monthly Report

### January, 2021

#### **Summary**

Covid-19 restrictions continue to limit company level surveys to the exterior of the buildings. While this is not as complete, it does give us a chance to concentrate on all exterior components that sometimes can be overlooked. This includes access points and any special hazards that may come into play during an emergency. Annual face piece fit testing was given to all department personnel at the drill field. Engine 2 personnel responded to 38 calls for service in the month of January.

#### **Personnel**

No personnel changes were made in the month of January.

#### **Apparatus/Equipment**

There were no mechanical issues with Engine 2 this month. PD picked up CP-17 for use as a mobile command post. It was returned without incident later in the day.

#### **Fire Stations/Facilities**

New electronic door locks were installed at Station 2 by an outside vendor and new key cards have been issued to all department personnel. There was a problem with the hot water at Station 2 and public works came to check the boilers. Minor adjustments have been made and we are keeping an eye on it. Facilities manager David Oakes was on scene with an outside vendor checking the building for A/C units and a generator upgrade.

#### **Miscellaneous**

Vaccines for Covid-19 are being offered to all BFD personnel and many have already received their second dose. The sooner everyone gets vaccinated the sooner we can all get back to a state of relative normalcy.
