January 2021

Summary

Tower 1 responded to 69 incidents during the month of January. Notable calls included 6 building fires, 1 industrial extrication of a victim from a machine, and 3 natural gas or propane leaks. Crews have continued conducting exterior surveys of target hazards. These totaled 6 different occupancies for a duration of 3 hours. This number is much lower due to the cold temperatures and snowy conditions.

Apparatus/Equipment

Tower 1 had a shelf in a compartment that was near failure due to the weight loading. Our Department mechanic reinforced the shelf and fixed the problem.

Fire Stations/Facilities

Overhead door installation is complete HQ. There are numerous issues with the doors operation and quality of installation. These issues are being addressed through the contractor and will hopefully be remedied soon.
