Summary

Engine Company 5 responded to 49 calls for service for the month of February. No formal surveys were conducted do to covid restrictions but several exterior walk thru and Knox box key checks were done. Also Street familiarization of our area was completed with several of the newly assigned firefighters.

Personnel

Station 5 has several firefighters cross training at Station 5. Firefighter Jordan Terrier is currently doing his station rotation at Engine Company 5 and Firefighters Lavoie and Wollman are here to learn Engine 5.

Apparatus/Equipment

Engine 5 was out for repairs this month, the air horn switch was repaired, and the truck was sent out at the end of the month due to the engine alarms activating and not resetting. Engine 7 was also out for some minor repairs and received 6 new lengths of 3in. hose.

Technicians inspected the firehouse to determine if a second computer with city internet could be installed in our study room to accommodate increasing demand for firefighters to do online courses. Bristol's I.T. dept. had the matter completed in short order and the firefighters appreciate the second computer.
