Engine 2

- E2-02: Flow test, CBRN cover replaced, purge valve replaced

- E3-01: Relief valve, X3 remote gauge replaced

Engine 5

- W5A: Replace collar mic
- EGR crossover tube for turbocharger replaced by Cummins
- Replace E-Z Wedge door tool

Tower 1

- Temporarily repair L/R section of body to allow the compartment to be used and the vehicle to be put back in service after accident. The insurance has inspected the damage, and we have been cut a check for the damage that is visible. I am currently waiting on the dealer to get back to me with a price quote.
- Replace air tank drain that was snapped off.

- Repair carb on Station 3's Honda trash pump
- Radio's on Tower 1 and Fire 1 were reprogrammed due to a I.D. issue
