ITEM #6 – NEW BUSINESS

ITEM #6A – CITY OWNED PROPERTY – GINA STREET

Attorney Steeg stated that he received a request to purchase City owned property on Gina Street. He inquired with the Assessor's Office to determine where the property was and doesn't see that the City owns any property on Gina Street. He will have to do more research on this.

Rob Long stated that he believed it was 182-A Gina Street which abuts up to the cul-de-sac and believes there is a sewer easement on the property.

ITEM #6B – REQUEST FROM D'AMATO ASSOCIATES LLC TO LEASE APPROXIMATELY 1.5 ACRES KNOWN AS LOT 3-31 ON 75 BATTISTO ROAD

Attorney Steeg stated that the City Council referred this matter to the Real Estate Committee, Public Works, Water Department and Planning for an 8-24 review. Ray Rogozinski stated that Public Works has it on their agenda and he will recommend a positive referral to the City Council. Rob Longo stated that he met with Mr. D'Amato and walked the property to see the area he would like to lease. He stated that it's basically an open field with no current use or planned use by the Water & Sewer Department. Mr. Longo stated that the Water & Sewer Commission were meeting later tonight and he would recommend a positive referral to the City Council as well.

Attorney Steeg stated that a Public Hearing will need to be conducted for the lease.

IT was MOVED by Councilwoman Barney and SECONDED by Councilman Kelley to this matter to a Public Hearing on July 9, 2020 at 5:00 and refer to the Corporation Counsel's Office for publication in the newspaper. All voted in favor.

IT was MOVED by Councilwoman Barney and SECONDED by Councilman Kelley to refer move the matter of Bloom Energy to the table. All voted in favor.

Ray Rogozinski stated that the Department of Public Works received a request from Bloom Energy Inc. to enter into a lease option for a portion of City property (Map 4 Lot 17-1), approximately 10,000 square feet for the purpose of installing a fuel cell. The portion of the parcel in question is within an un-used portion of the Department of Public Works' transfer station facility. Option payment is \$1,000.00 with a year for option period 7-13-2020 – 7-13-2020. Then they propose a 21-year lease with lease payment starting at \$20,000.00 with a 2% escalation rate.

IT was MOVED by Councilwoman Barney and SECONDED by Councilman Kelley to refer this matter to a Public Hearing on July 9, 2020 at 5:00 and refer to the Corporation Counsel's Office for publication in the newspaper. All voted in favor.
