1. Call to Order

3. Approval of Minutes

MOTION: Made by Commissioner Piotrowski to accept the August 10, 2020 meeting minutes.

4. Old Business by Commissioners

Chairman Saman stated that he found D/2 at \$189 for a five gallon container at Atlas in Southington, CT.

Commissioner Piotrowski stated that Lewis Street and possibly Downs are in need of tree limb trimming and removal. Stated a Tree climber would be needed.

5. New Business by Commissioners

Chairman Saman reviewed the quote from Christoph Henning. Suggested doing a few stones a little at a time. Commissioner Piotrowski requested that we just accept the full quote since we know we have the Trust money coming. Chairman Saman stated the quote would be with an additional \$600 for a second lves stone. Chairman Saman also brought up the fence that needs to be repaired as well. Pepin Steel quoted \$5,000 maximum to remove the fence from the ground, set the cement forms again, sand blast the fence, repair some of the welding's and epoxy coat it which will allow the fence to last for another 100 or so years. State grant of \$1,600 could be put toward the fence if we receive the grant and then the remainder of the funds from the Pardee trust.

MOTION: Made by Commissioner Piotrowski to accept Christoph Hennings quote plus the extra \$600 for the additional Ives Stone for \$5,025.

Seconded by Commissioner Arbesman.

All in favor; motion passed.

MOTION: Made by Commissioner Piotrowski to go ahead with Pepin Steel to do the fencing, when the funds become available from the Sarah Norton Pardee Trust, then we will secure Pepin Steel to do the work.

Seconded by Commissioner Arbesman.

All in favor; motion passed.
