Justin Malley reviewed the status of estimated costs of the Hope Street Parking Garage, which is approximately \$1.3 million short. If funded by ARPA they do not have to follow Davis Bacon prevailing wages, but if funded from City/Bonds the project would need to include prevailing wage.

Discussion was held on the Barnes Chapel projects. Mayor Caggiano made a motion seconded by Commissioner O'Brien "to allocate \$5,460 for a study of the chapel repair needs." Motion approved.
