The prevalence rate of students with disabilities in Connecticut is 15% and trending upward. At a fall 2019 Alliance Symposium it was reported that some Alliance districts are as high as 29% identification rate at that time.

The prevalence rate in Bristol fluctuates monthly and has ranged from 19% to 23% during the previous year as well as since the start of the current school year. As of February 3, 2020, the prevalence rate in Bristol was 20.98%. With 1757 of 8375 Bristol Public School students identified as eligible for special education programming, the prevalence rate in Bristol as of January 2, 2020 is 20.57%. Additionally, we have conducted approximately 143 risk assessments since August 1, 2019.
