The prevalence rate of students with disabilities in Connecticut is 15% and trending upward. At a fall 2019 Alliance Symposium it had been reported that some Alliance districts were as high as 29% identification rate at that time.

The prevalence rate in Bristol fluctuates monthly and has ranged from 19% to 23% during the previous year as well as since the start of the current school year. As of March 2, 2020, the prevalence rate in Bristol is 20.94 %, with 1750 of 8356 Bristol Public School students identified as eligible for special education programming. The prevalence rate as of February 2, 2020 had been 20.98%. Additionally, we have conducted approximately 170 risk assessments since August 1, 2019.
