Dear Mr. Smith:

The Bristol Board of Education voted at its meeting held on September 9, 2020 to request a transfer of funds from its general fund surplus to the cafeteria fund in order to cover an end of year deficit amount. Below is the motion that was approved.

Motion: Move that the Board of Education make a formal request to the City Comptroller's Office to transfer three-hundred seventy-nine thousand, five-hundred and thirty-two dollars (\$379,532) from the BOE General Fund Surplus to balance the Cafeteria Fund Deficit. This action will result in a FY20 surplus balance of one million three-hundred ninety-three thousand seven-hundred and two dollars (\$1,393,702).

In addition, the Board of Education Finance Committee voted at its meeting on September 2nd to request that the balance of the Board of Education surplus be set-aside in a separate fund, in order to mitigate any FY21 deficit due to expenses associated with the Covid-19 pandemic, and/or any special education shortfall. Below is the motion that was approved.

Motion: Move that the Board of Education make a formal request to the City Comptroller's Office to set aside the FY20 surplus balance of one million three-hundred ninety-three thousand seven-hundred and two dollars (\$1,393,702), for purposes of funding expenses associated with the Covid-19 pandemic and/or expenses associated with special education expenses that exceed budgeted amounts.

At this time, we respectfully request the transfer of \$379,532 to the cafeteria fund, and set-aside of the remaining surplus balance of \$1,393,702.
