Homeowners Tax Relief Requirements for the Elderly and Totally Disabled

**APPLICATIONS ARE TAKEN IN THE ASSESSORS OFFICE
MONDAY – FRIDAY – 9:00 AM – 12:00 PM AND 2:00 PM – 4:00 PM**

1. File between **February 1, 2022** through **May 15, 2022**.
 2. Driver's license or birth certificate showing that you or your spouse must have been 65 years of age by December 31, 2021
 3. If you are not 65, you must be over 18 and social security disabled. You must submit a recent ***BPOY*** printout or **Benefit Verification Letter** from Social Security indicating that you are a disabled individual and the date which the disability began.
 4. Maximum income: **Single \$38,100**
Married \$46,400
 5. Proof of all 2021 income:
 - Pension
 - Bank Interest
 - Social Security (Including Medicare)
 - Any other income from 2021Qualifying income is **total income** for IRS **plus Social Security income including Medicare**.
 6. In order for us to process your claim a copy of your **SSA 1099 Form** must accompany your application.
 7. If you file a **2021 Federal Income Tax return**, we must have a copy.
 8. You must own the property or have life use of the property and be liable for payment of taxes. (Ownership as of October 1, 2021)
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
