This policy applies to emergency mutual aid between the Bristol Police Department and Public Works Staff.

Active Assailant protocol for the Public Works Department will include the Streets and Solid Waste Divisions. These divisions will assist in road closures during such incidents.

8. Roles/Responsibilities

It is the responsibility of the Public Works Streets and Solid Waste Superintendents to deploy the fleet to the location given by the Bristol Police Department. Vehicles will be used to create a road closure.

It is the responsibility of the Public Works Director, management and/or supervisory staff involved in an event that entails a Press Release to ensure that the Public Works Analyst is kept aware of changes in the situation as they occur and that communications are frequent and proactive.
