22.1 SERVICE FOR RESIDENTIAL BORDER PROPERTIES

1. Policy Name

Service for Residential Border Properties

2. Responsible Division and Effective Date.

Public Works Solid Waste Division

3. Rationale or Purpose

This policy is designed to reflect the City of Bristol's policy for providing Solid Waste services to residential properties that are on the perimeter of the City and pay taxes to both the City of Bristol and another municipality.

4. Policy Statement

This policy defines the City Solid Waste services that will be provided on residential border properties that pay taxes to Bristol and another municipality.

5. Scope

This policy applies to City Solid Waste services that will be provided to residential properties on border streets meeting the criteria of this policy.

6. Procedures – City Solid Waste Services Provided on Residential Border Properties

The City of Bristol shall furnish Solid Waste services [outlined below] to the occupants of residential dwelling houses on properties that border Bristol and one other municipality provided:

- a) Such properties pay less than 51% of total property taxes to the City of Bristol.
- b) Such properties pay services fees set by the Board of Public Works for such services.

Included services available:

- a) Weekly curbside rubbish, bi-weekly curbside recycle (including leaf bag and holiday tree) collection.
- b) Weekly seasonal yard waste
- c) Bulk collections (must be scheduled).
- d) Transfer Station use – see www.bristolct.gov/respayt

Other services:

- a) Residents of border properties may only use Household Hazardous Waste and Electronic Waste Collections if the address shown on their driver's license is Bristol or the city shown on their license qualifies to use the collection through the sponsors of the collection.

7. Roles/Responsibilities

- a) Property owner is responsible to pay fees for services desired.

- b) Property owner is responsible to schedule services as appropriate.
- c) Public Works is responsible for providing the services that the property is eligible to receive once appropriate payment has been received.

8. Definitions

- a) Border Property or Perimeter property: A residential property whose boundaries are located in Bristol and at least one other municipality that borders Bristol.

10. Consequences of Non-Compliance

The City of Bristol will not provide services to border properties that do not meet the criteria of this policy. The City of Bristol will terminate any/all of the listed services if property owner fails to pay service fees when due.

Curbside Rubbish and Recycling: \$275.00 per year – weekly rubbish collection and bi-weekly recycle collection

Yard Waste Collection Service: \$90.00 per year, seasonal weekly collection mid-April through mid-November. See www.bristolct.gov/yardwaste

Bulk Collection: \$25.00 per scheduled occurrence with a limit of 5 CY (approximately 3'Wx3'Hx15'L)
