#### **ROADWAY SHARED BIKE SYMBOLS**

August 7, 2025

The Department of Public Works has installed shared road bike symbols in the downtown and Rockwell Park area. The shared bike road symbols are painted roadway markings to indicate to drivers the potential of cyclists utilizing the road. The installation of the shared bike symbols is consistent with The Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD). The work is being performed as part of a State Community Connectivity grant to make City streets more accessible to cyclists and pedestrian traffic. The project includes installation of sidewalks and ADA ramps. Installation of the shared road bike symbols are consistent with the recently approved Board of Public Works Complete Street policy and “safe street for all” initiatives.

The Department of Public Works’ objective is to increase roadway access to cyclists & pedestrians to calm traffic & reduce speeds. Other City initiatives to calm traffic and increase accessibility on City streets include the construction of roadway streetscapes, reducing roadway width, installing center islands, reducing road radii, installing rumble strips, and additional signage.
